



#### **Trade Marks**

The enactment of the Trade Marks Act, 2013 and the Trade Marks Regulations, 2015 (which were brought into force on September 1st 2015), represents the first step in the modernisation of the Territory's suite of intellectual and industrial property legislation. Both enactments respectively repeal the Trade Marks Act, 1887 and the Trade Marks Rules, 1947.

A noteworthy feature of the new Trade Marks legislation is the requirement that the registration of trademarks must be carried out through Trade Mark Agents who must be approved by the FSC. Any individual, corporate entity or partnership may apply to act as a Trade Mark Agent.
