WHEREAS it is provided by section 1(2) of the Insolvency Act, 2003 that the provisions of the said Act come into operation on such date or dates as may be appointed by the Governor by Proclamation published in the *Gazette* and different dates may be appointed for different provisions and different purposes;

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in me, I do hereby proclaim that all the provisions of the Insolvency Act, 2003, except Parts III and XVIII, shall come into force on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2004;

AND all Her Majesty's loving subjects are hereby required to take note hereof and govern themselves accordingly.
